



First U.S. Scholarship Guidelines

The following guidelines will apply to the application and awarding of two \$1,000 scholarships:

Two (2) Existing Member Scholarship: One to a current high school senior, bound for college in the fall of 2018, and one for a student currently enrolled at a college, university or career college that will be enrolled to continue in the fall of 2018.

Eligibility Requirements

The applicant must:

1. Be a First U.S. member in good standing
2. Be a graduating high school student or continuing college student
3. Maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 (on 4.0 scale)

Application Requirements

1. A completed Scholarship Application
2. A personal statement essay (in 250 words or less) answering the following questions:
 - a. What life experiences or achievements have helped you get to this point in life?
 - b. What are your extra-curricular activities? What types of leadership positions have you held?
 - c. What is your intended academic curriculum?
 - d. How will you maximize the opportunities of higher education?
 - e. How will you apply what you have learned to your post-college plans and aspirations?
3. An un-opened, certified copy of your transcript that must be certified by a school official
4. One letter of recommendation from a teacher

Award Criteria

1. GPA: 25%
2. Personal Statement Essay: 20%
3. Honors and Awards: 15%
4. Employment and Community Service: 15%
5. Leadership and Extracurricular Activities: 15%
6. Current Events Question: 10%
7. **Acceptance into a community college, career college or four-year college or university for the 2018-2019 academic year**
8. **Full-time enrollment of 12 or more credits or units**

Timelines

1. Scholarship Applications will be available at any First U.S. Branch location or at firstus.org.
2. Completed applications must be received at the credit union by close of business on September 3, 2018.
3. Scholarships will be awarded after September 15, 2018. After confirmation of registration and acceptance at school, award checks will be made out to the college or the award recipient.

DEADLINE: Must be received by September 3, 2018

IMPORTANT INFORMATION BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Applications must be received at First U.S. Community Credit Union by September 3, 2018. You must be a member of First U.S. as of the date that you submit the application as a graduating high school senior or currently enrolled college student in the 2018-2019 school year. Applications will not be returned and will become the property of First U.S. First U.S. officers, employees and their families are not eligible. The winning entries will be chosen at the discretion of First U.S. staff and may employ a committee of federal employee members. Illegible entries may be disqualified. Winners will be notified after September 15, 2018 by mail or phone and agree to have their names and photos published in First U.S. promotional materials. After confirmation of registration and/or acceptance at a two-year community college or a four-year college or university with 12 or more credits or units in classes, award checks will be issued to the award recipient or their school. Not valid where prohibited by law.

 - a. What life experiences or achievements have helped you get to this point in life?
 - b. What are your extra-curricular activities? What types of leadership positions have you held?
 - c. What is your intended academic curriculum?
 - d. How will you maximize the opportunities of higher education?
 - e. How will you apply what you have learned to your post-college plans and aspirations?
2. An un-opened, certified copy of your transcript that must be certified by a school official
3. One letter of recommendation from a teacher verifying your scholastic honors and awards, leadership, extracurricular activities, community involvement and employment, listed below

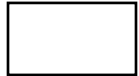
